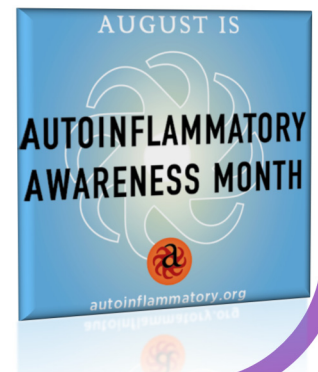


### McLamb Family Auto-inflammatory Disorder

9. Keener area—Union Grove Church (Hobbstown)
10. Keener Road to homesite of Alexander McLamb (Frank McLamb)
11. Keener Road to Church Road to Point Level Church Cemetery
